Greetings to New Families!!

We are excited for your family to join our CBES family!

Here is some important information to help ensure a smooth transition.

#### **Building Hours**

School hours are from 8:30 a.m. until 3:35 p.m.

Students arriving prior to 8:25 may be on the playground or in the cafeteria until the first bell at 8:25. Breakfast is served from 8:00-8:20. Students will start heading to their classrooms at 8:25.

Dismissal is at 3:35 on M, T, Th, and F. Early Release dismissal time is 1:50 on Wednesdays.

In order to limit adult presence in the building, we ask that parents pick up and drop off their students on the playground. Parents/Guardians may enter the building through the front doors if they have a pre-arranged meeting or for another approved purpose.

In the interest of safety, students should not arrive at school prior to 8:00, and should leave the school grounds by 3:50 unless they are involved in a supervised before or after school activity.

## **School Supplies**

School supply kits will be available through 1st Day School Supplies. These custom built kits have all of the classroom supplies required by CBCS teachers. All supply kits will be shipped directly to your home at least 2 weeks prior to the first day of school. This is a service provided by the CBCS PTA and NOT a fundraiser. **Wednesday Workshops.** K-5 students are invited to join us for fun arts & crafts, games, science, STEM activities, and homework help each week at CBCS on Wednesdays from 1:50-3:30PM. Students will focus on a different activity every three weeks. Wednesday Workshops are very affordable - only a \$25 supply fee per student each semester. Students on the Free & Reduced School Lunch Program are free. Wednesday Workshops start on September 2nd and go through the school year.

**Enrichment Program After School Clubs, and After Club Care** 

The Enrichment Program offers a number of After School Clubs (Lego & Nature clubs for K-2 students; Robotics, Garden and Kids' Radio clubs for 3-5 students). We will also offer After Club Care on Tuesdays, Wednesdays & Thursdays until 5:30 for a small fee. We understand that "life happens" and it is sometimes difficult to pick up your child on time after their activity ends.

Registration for Wednesday Workshops, Enrichment Program After School Clubs, and After Care will open on the week before school starts.

If you need to come to the school to pick up your child, drop something off, or conduct other school related business, please come to the main entrance and check in at the office. The Office Managers will be happy to help facilitate what you need.
